## IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR! FILE BEFORE THE DEADLINE!

### Apply for Financial Aid Early

Though next year may not be on your mind right now, it must be for...it is very important to apply for financial aid early, as the College offers a limited amount of funding each year on a first-come, first served basis. The college's priority deadline is **April 1, 2013**, but you are welcome to file your FAFSA sooner. If you and your student haven't completed your 2012 taxes, you can still file the FAFSA using estimated figures and update the information using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool once your taxes have been filed.

Students who are New Jersey residents will also be considered for the Tuition Aid Grant (TAG), funded by the New Jersey Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA). Eligibility is based on information provided in your FAFSA in addition to other information requested directly by HESAA. The state deadline to file the FAFSA is **June 1, 2013**.

Both the College and HESAA will contact your student if they need additional information to determine eligibility for financial aid. Please remind your student to read and respond to any letters, e-mails or other correspondence from Centenary College and HESAA. Centenary College also has a Facebook page that you and your family can "Like" to stay informed on important filing deadlines, outside scholarships and other information related to financial aid.

Centenary College is pleased to announce that it is one of 10 colleges in New Jersey to participate in New Jersey College Goal Sunday from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. **February 24, 2013**. This event was made possible through the New Jersey Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA) and the New Jersey Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators (NJASFAA).

During this event, volunteer financial aid professionals from around the state - including Centenary's Director of Financial Aid, Evelynne Blatt, and the entire Centenary Financial Aid Office staff will work one-on-one with students and families to help them complete and submit the electronic Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

In addition to being open to high school students, members of the adult population are invited, including the unemployed, underemployed or those returning from military service. College Goal Sunday can also provide financial aid information and assistance to those who may need retraining or further education.

Those who attend have the opportunity to win a \$500 scholarship. "This is a terrific opportunity for people to learn about the financial aid process, which is a critical part of the college application procedure," says Blatt. "It is our intention to answer questions and inform the public, so this experience is one that is positive and productive." Come complete your Federal Student Aid Application.

The School of International Programs is conducting a three month ESL/Teaching Methodology program for 13 public school teachers from Korea. The program began on Dec. 13, 2012 and runs through Feb 22, 2013. This special program has been coordinated through ITTI Global, Inc. in Seoul, Korea, who worked with the School of International Programs on a previous month long program in the summer of 2012. Both programs are funded by the Korean government.

For the first two months of the winter program the teachers participated in an on-campus program that focused on writing skills and English pronunciation. During the last month, 4 teachers will be experiencing practical training at the Hackettstown Middle School in grades 5 through 8, where they will learn about the American public school education system.

The match came down to the final bout as senior J.D. Zitone took down Michael Boardman for a pin at 1:11 to put the Cyclones on top and give them the win over the Aggies. The match was the first time that two Top 10 nationally ranked teams squared off in the John M. Reeves Student Recreation Center. The Cyclones were able to run away with the victory to improve them to 8-3 on the season as the #6 ranked team in the nation.
