# SARAH BLANCHARD



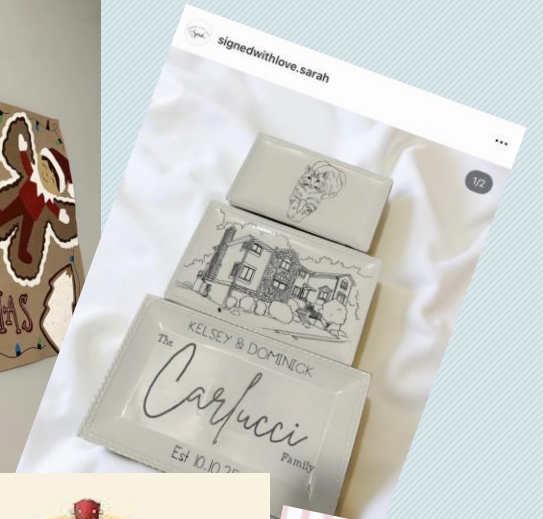

I have two dogs, I love to travel, listen to music, and hang out with my family, friends and boyfriend.

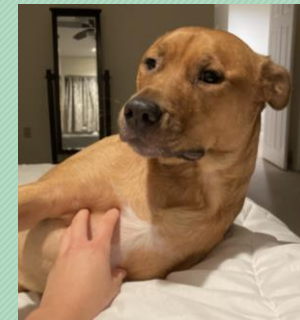


# Alixandra Ditchey

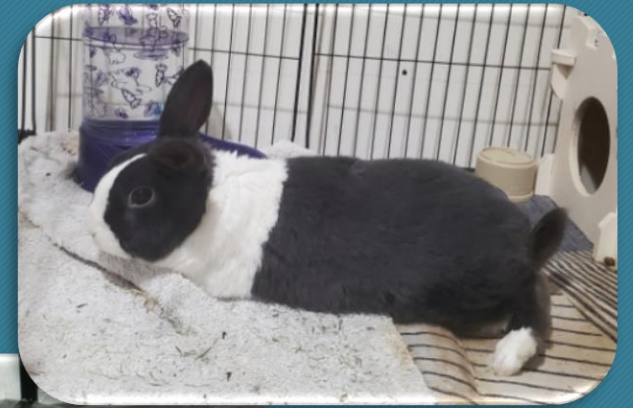

# Nora Dornich



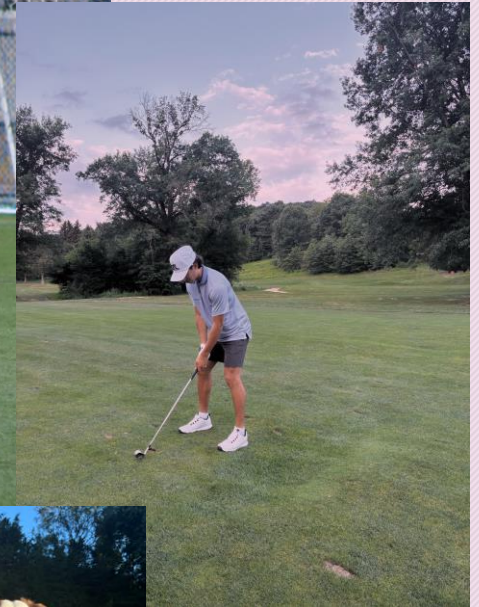

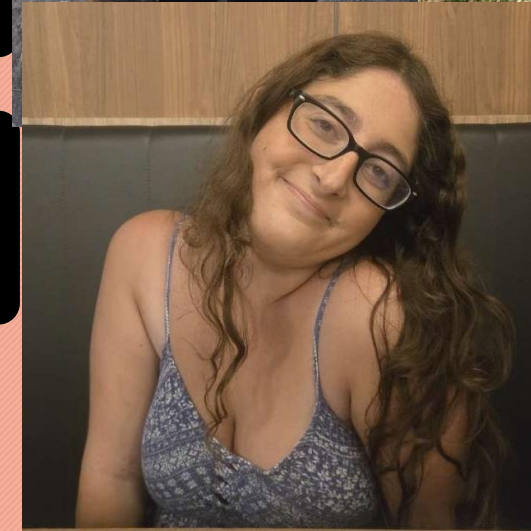
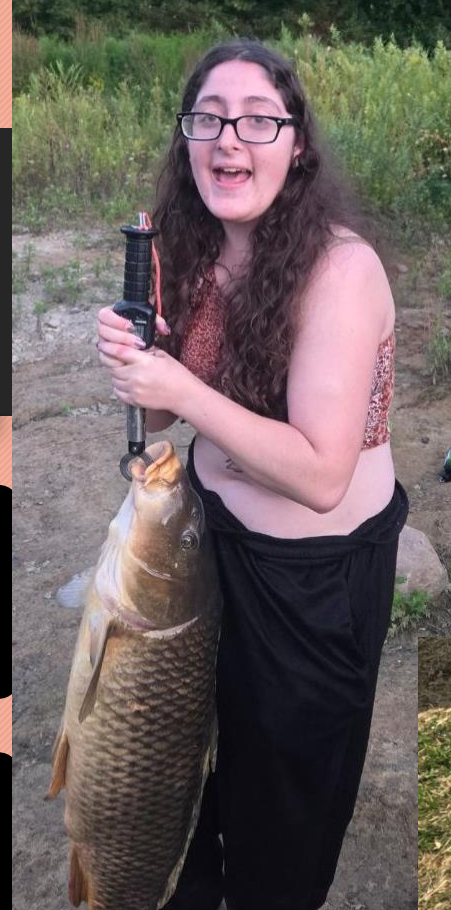


# Alaina Okun

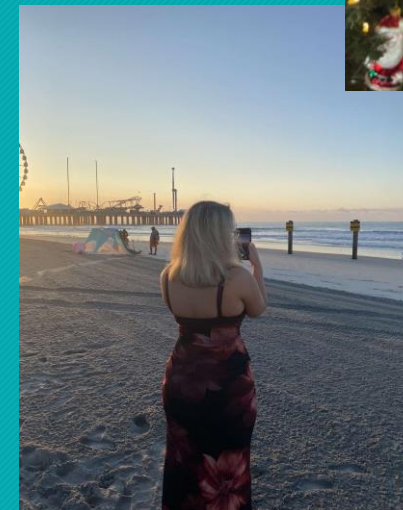
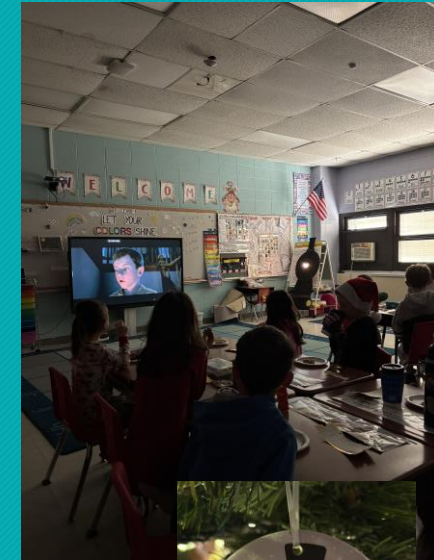

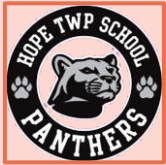
I had so many amazing teachers in elementary school, they inspired me to be just like them and to create a safe, fun, loving, and inclusive environment for students to learn and be themselves.

# Jillian Pullis



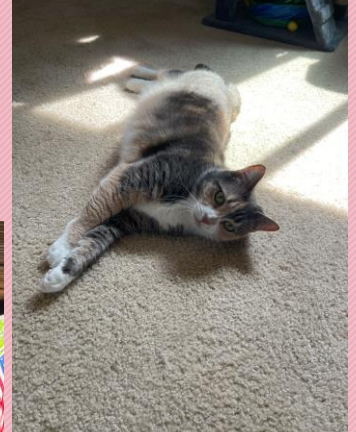
Preschool Teacher for the Vernon Township School District

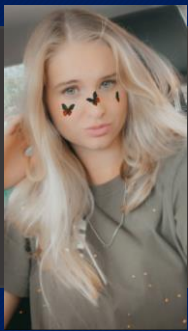
# Jessica Smith

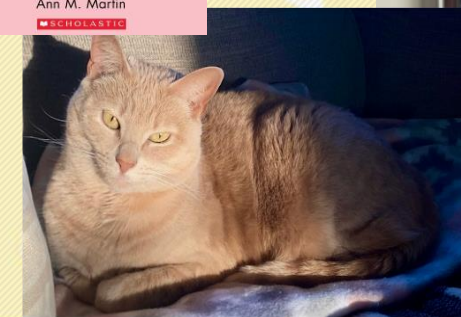
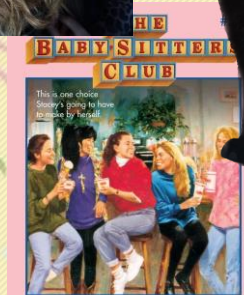
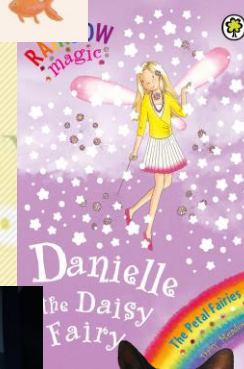
