



SMOKING POLICY

In accordance with New Jersey State law and the New Jersey Smoke Free Air Act, smoking is not permitted in any building on the Centenary University campus. Smoking refers to the burning of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other device, as well as the use of vape pens and e-cigarettes. There is no smoking within 25 feet of any building. When smoking outdoors, smoking must take place 25 feet or more away from any building. Use caution when smoking, as lit cigarettes, cigars, etc. can result in unintended fires when improperly disposed.

Enforcement of the smoking policy is the responsibility of all of us. Any member of the community observing an infraction of the smoking policy is encouraged to remind violators of our policy. Centenary community members are also responsible for making sure their guests obey all regulations. Infractions may be documented. Complaints may be addressed to the Student Life Office or to the Human Resources Department.
