Payment Options

Be sure to check out our Tuition and Fees pages at CentenaryUniversity.edu/StudentAccounts for more information on payment options and payment deadlines for each term.

- **Online payments or In-person payments:** Payments from a checking account, Visa, MasterCard or Discover Card may be made by logging into your my.Centenary account or in the Student Accounts Office. Payments made by credit/debit card will be charged a 2.65% service fee. Payments submitted via e-check will not be charged a service fee.
- **Deferred Payment Options:** Students using an employer reimbursement plan can sign up for Deferred Payment. Students will have 30 days from the last day of the term to submit payment in full. Employer program verification from a manager or your Human Resources department is required in order to participate in the program.
- **Employer Direct Payment:** For employers who pay Centenary directly, employees will need to provide a letter of credit (LOC) from their employer prior to the term payment due date.

Putting it All Together

- Once you are admitted to Centenary, your Enrollment Counselor will share with you the process to request your discounts.
- Submit your FAFSA online at fafsa.gov. You will need to complete your Entrance Counseling and Master Promissory Note (MPN).
- Contact our Office of Veteran Services if you are a veteran.
- Work with your Enrollment Counselor to plan your degree.
- Discuss your payment option with the Student Accounts Office.
