Centenary offers a streamlined transfer process for traditional undergraduate students. We promise to deliver a straightforward transfer experience. Here's how...

Single Point of Contact: Your Centenary Enrollment Counselor will help you with the admissions process, and also serves as your interim advisor to guide your selection of program and classes. If you have any questions, there's one person to call.

Transfer Credit Policy: Centenary accepts up to 66 qualified credits from an accredited community college, and up to 90 credits from another accredited four-year college.

Free Credit Evaluation: Centenary will provide a free, no-obligation evaluation of your credits. You may be surprised how close you are to completing your bachelor's degree!

Articulation Agreements: Centenary has articulation agreements with several community colleges in New Jersey that make the transfer of your college credits to Centenary simple and seamless.

Transfer Admission Requested Items

Here's all you need to complete your Centenary University transfer application:

- A completed Admissions Application. Choose either our secure online application or the Common Application
- Official college transcripts from all prior institutions
- Proof of high school graduation (diploma or transcript copy)

If you have fewer than 24 completed college credits to transfer, we will need your official high school transcript.





Financial Aid & Scholarships

As a transfer student, you may be eligible for financial aid and scholarships including:

- GPA-based Merit Award
- Recognition Award (for students with an associate degree)
- Phi Theta Kappa Member Scholarship

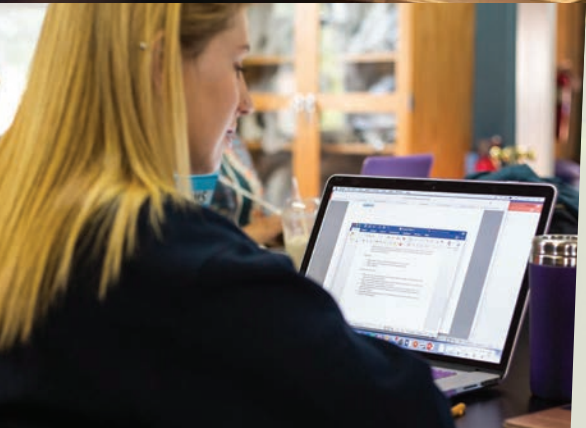

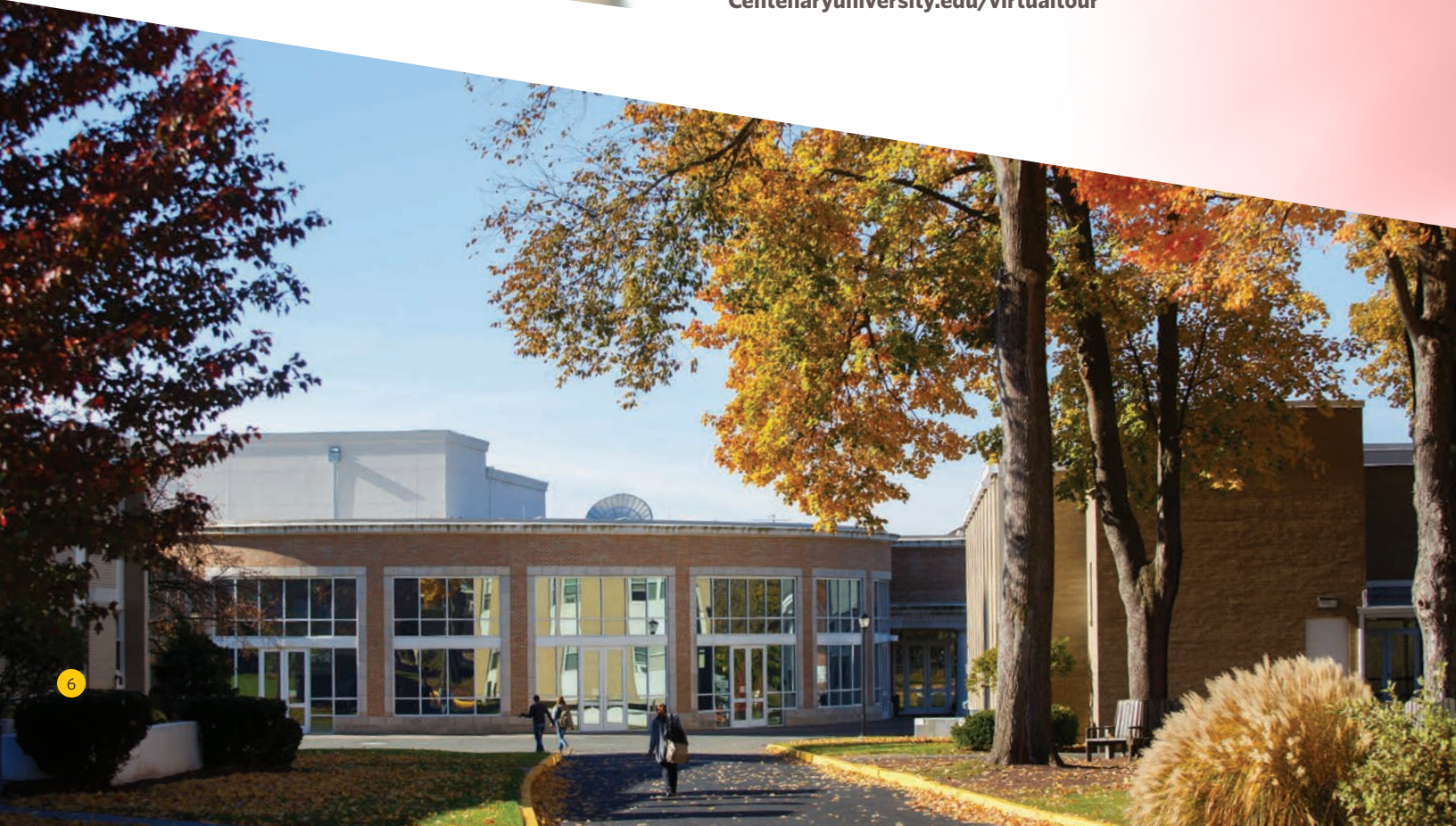
