Notes

- 1. To earn a Bachelor degree, all graduates must successfully complete a minimum of 120 credit hours.
2. Minimum of 30 credits must be taken at Centenary University.
3. All graduates must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or above.
4. All graduates must have a minimum of 2.0 GPA in their major(s).
5. Courses that are listed as special topic, typically ending with a 99, are repeatable.
6. Credits can be shared between the core and the major, or between the core and minor.
7. The Equine department recommends MTH 1111 Quantitative Literacy for one of the STEM Engagement requirements.
8. The Equine department recommends BUS 1105 for the Broad and Enduring Interest requirement.
9. Students in this major are encouraged to take either EDU 2000 or SOC 1000 to fulfill their Social & Community Responsibility core requirement.
10. Internship can be extended to 4 credits to replace an elective. Internship must take place at a PATH Intl. Premier Accredited Center or at a site approved by the Director of Therapeutic Riding At Centenary.
