- your parent(s) refuse to provide information for the FAFSA or for verification
- your parent(s) do not claim you on their tax return
- you have the ability to, or currently, support yourself

- A detailed explanation of how you are supporting yourself. If someone else is providing your support, please indicate to what extent.
- Statements and supporting documentation from at least **two** disinterested third parties who are aware of your situation. A third party may not be a relative or friend. Please provide documentation that is on letterhead where appropriate. All statements must be signed and dated.
