




Average net price of attendance for full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who were awarded Title IV aid by income: 2018-19 - 2020-21

Unduplicated 12-month headcount and total FTE, by student level: 2020-21




Enrollment by gender, student level, and full- and part-time status: Fall 2021




Percent of all students enrolled, by race/ethnicity: Fall 2021




Percent of all students enrolled, by age: Fall 2021





First to second year retention rates of first-time bachelor's degree-seeking undergraduates: Fall 2021






Graduation rates of full-time, first-time, degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates within 150% of normal time to program completion, by Title IV aid status: 2015 cohort




Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2013-14, by cohort



Award and enrollment rates of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students who entered the institution in 2013-14, by Pell status and cohort



Percent of full-time, first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status



Percent of part-time, first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status





4 Years after entry 6 Years after entry






Percent of part-time, non-first-time entering students receiving an award at four, six, and eight years after entry, by type of award and Pell status

4 Years after entry




Percent distribution of core revenues, by source: Fiscal year 2021




